

### THINGS YOU Should know

#### 01

Our swimming pool opens each year the week before Memorial Day and closes around the first week of October.

#### 02

Beach chairs are available for your use. They're located in the outdoor storage space to the right of the laundry room--across from the elevator. Please return all items where you found them when you're done.


#### 03

Smoking is **not allowed** in the condo or balcony, in any of the common areas of the building such as hallway corridors, stairwells, elevators, lobby, cabana, cabana restrooms, etc.

#### 04

If a child is not potty trained and does not have proper swim diapers and has an accident in the pool, a fine may be assessed in the amount of \$150 in order to chemically treat the pool.

Now, about **glass** – we want to keep our pool and cabana areas safe for everyone. So, please remember that glass is a no-go in those areas. If, by chance, any glass is broken around the pool, we'll need to go through the whole process of draining, cleaning, refilling, and balancing the pool. It's a bit of a hassle, which is why there's a \$500 fine to cover it. Just so you know, management does have surveillance cameras around the property. So, if anything does happen, management will check things out and sort out any fees accordingly. Thanks a bunch for helping us keep our pool area in tip-top shape for everyone to enjoy!


Sorry, smoking is strictly prohibited on our property (HOA rules) and animals are not allowed.





### THE ISLANDER RULES + REGS

- **BALCONIES:** Nothing should be hung from the balcony railings, walls or from clotheslines placed on the balcony. No cooking is allowed on the balcony or the roof. DO NOT FEED THE BIRDS FROM THE BALCONY.
- 1st FLOOR FIRE DOORS, ROOF, CORRIDORS AND STAIRWELLS: Fire doors (1ST FLOOR) are not to be used as a regular entrance or exit. No one (except Management and maintenance people) is allowed on the roof. Corridors and stairwells are to be kept free of lounge chairs, bicycles, shoes, sand toys, etc.
- FOOD AND BEVERAGES: Barbecue grills are handled on a first come first serve basis. Turn off gas and clean grills after each use. Clean up the cabana area when you leave.
- **TRASH:** All trash must be placed in plastic trash bags, bags tied securely and deposited in the trash chute. Trash that does not fit down the trash chute should be carried to the outside dumpster area. Refrain from placing trash down the trash chute before 8:00 a.m. and after 10:00 p.m.
- **SMOKING:** No smoking is allowed in any of the common areas within the building (hallways, elevators, stairwells, laundry rooms, lobby, etc.).
- **LAUNDRY FACILITIES:** Do not leave laundry in the machines after the cycle has been completed. No tints or dyes should be used in the machines. Clean the dryer filter after use. Clean up the laundry area before leaving. Keep the laundry room door closed.
- **NOISE:** Noise from a stereo, TV, radio or musical instruments should be kept within the confines of your unit.
- **PARKING:** Park your vehicle in your assigned parking space. Boats, trailers, jet skis and campers are not allowed in the parking lot. Please do not wash cars in the parking lot. An owner's sticker or parking permit must be displayed on your vehicle at all times. Renters will not be provided more than two parking passes unless approved in advance by the Building Manager.
- **PETS:** Pets are not allowed in the units, building or grounds, except as may be permitted by law.
- SERVICE ANIMALS: A formal written request for accommodation for a service animal must be submitted, in writing, to the Board for consideration. The following Rules and Regulations related to service animals MUST be followed at all times:
  POOL RULES: in the pool is permitted from 8:00 a.m. 10:00 p.m.
- Since the pool is not guarded, you are using the facility at your own risk. A responsible adult must accompany children. Rubber rafts and other such items are not permitted (exception life jacket, life bubble).
- Children not toilet trained must wear swim diapers.
- Beverages are allowed only in <u>non-breakable</u> containers. **\$500 FINE FOR BROKEN GLASS**
- Shower when coming from the beach and before using the pool. Please ensure water is turned off completely at the shower area.
- Dry off before entering the building.
- Pool furniture is not to be removed from the pool area.
- Cabana restrooms are locked at all times (access is with your unit door key).
- TENNIS: Tennis court is available for play from 8:00 a.m. 9:00 p.m. The general principles of tennis etiquette will prevail at all times. Plays will be limited to one (1) hour when others are waiting to use the facility. Tennis shoes should be worn at all times. The tennis court gate is to be locked at all times (access is with your unit door key). Skateboards, roller blades, etc. are not allowed on the court.


#### Wrightsville Beach General Guidelines

Before you hit the shoreline, be sure and familiarize yourself with these Wrightsville-Beach specific regulations and guidelines that will ensure your stay is enjoyable and safe throughout.

- <u>Surf fishing</u> is allowed throughout Wrightsville Beach, except from area bridges, (which includes the Banks Channel Bridge.) A saltwater fishing license is required for anglers age 16 and older, which can be picked up at local bait and tackle stores, or obtained online through the North Carolina Wildlife Resources Commission's website.
- Sea turtles occasionally nest on the local beaches, and visitors should note that it is illegal to harass, molest, collect, or otherwise harm sea turtle nests. Be respectful of closures for sea turtle or endangered bird nesting.
- Smoking is not allowed on the beach strand in the town of Wrightsville Beach.
- Littering is not permitted in Wrightsville Beach, and could result in a fine.
- It is illegal to leave up any beach equipment overnight in the town of Wrightsville Beach, which includes tents, canopies, umbrellas, and other beach gear.
- Do not walk on the sand dunes, or remove any vegetation from the oceanfront shoreline.
- Glass containers of any type are not allowed in Wrightsville Beach.
- Cooking devices, such as grills or portable camping stoves, are not allowed on the beaches of Wrightsville Beach.
- Wrightsville Beach's local noise ordinance states that visitors should refrain from creating any unreasonably loud and / or disturbing sound levels within the town.
- Visitors should fill any man-made holes before they leave the beach to avoid injury to other beach-goers, or cause a hazard for emergency 4WD vehicles that need to access the sand.
- Wrightsville Beach has 13 lifeguard stands within the town from Memorial Day weekend until Labor Day weekend. The Ocean Rescue Team staffs the lifeguard stands daily in the summer months from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- Please pay close attention to the signal flags stationed along the shoreline, which indicate the current swimming conditions. A green flag means that conditions are calm and conducive for swimming. A yellow flag indicates that moderate surf and / or currents are present, and swimmers should exercise caution when entering the ocean. A red flag indicates that conditions may be too dangerous and hazardous to swim, and a double red and white flag indicates that the beach is closed.
- Watch for other folks sharing the water when swimming, especially surfers, kayakers, and other wave-riders who frequent the shore.
- Be on the lookout for rip currents, which can occur in all weather conditions. Swim at life-guarded beaches whenever possible, and swim parallel to the shore if you are caught in a current, until you can safely swim back to the beach once again.
- Weddings and special events are allowed on Wrightsville Beach. Approval before the big day is required from <u>Wrightsville Beach</u> <u>Parks and Recreation</u>, and a small permit fee may apply.
- paid Parking is available for day-trippers on a first come, first serve basis, and may be limited on weekends and holidays, due to local traffic. Arrive early or late in order to secure a parking space close to the beach.



### RIP CURRENTS KNOW YOUR OPTIONS




Rip currents are powerful currents of water moving away from shore. They can sweep even the strongest swimmer away from shore. If at all possible, swim near a lifeguard.

#### SAFETY AND RULES TO KNOW

- 1. **Rip Currents Awareness**: Rip currents are powerful, narrow channels of fast-moving water prevalent at Wrightsville Beach. If caught in one, remain calm and swim parallel to the shore until you are out of the current, then swim back to shore.
- 2. Understanding Lifeguard Flags: Lifeguards use a flag system to communicate beach conditions. A green flag indicates calm conditions, yellow signifies moderate hazards, and red warns of high danger, such as strong currents or rough surf. Always heed these flags for your safety.
- 3. Fill In Holes: Holes dug in the sand can be hazardous not only to other beachgoers but also to
  - sea turtles, especially during nesting season. Please fill in any holes you dig to prevent injuries and ensure the safety of our marine friends.
- 4. Sea Turtle Nests: Be mindful of sea turtle nests, which are often marked and protected. Disturbing these nests is harmful to the turtles and illegal. Keep a respectful distance to help protect these endangered creatures.
- 5. **Dune Protection**: Walking on the dunes is prohibited, as it can damage the fragile ecosystem and contribute to erosion. Fines are enforced to protect these vital barriers. Use designated walkways to access the beach.

6. DO NOT LITTER. \$250-\$1000 FINE.
